



16th Hole – 460m Mens & 377m Ladies – Par 5

The sixteenth hole requires a straight drive from the tee to set up a second shot around a left hand dogleg. From the tee, the ball needs to be negotiated through the “narrows” formed by encroaching box trees on the left and large gums on the right. At the corner, the fairway falls down towards the green, providing good dividends to a well struck shot.

It is not uncommon to see the large population of kangaroos grazing lazily along the edges of this hole.
